- 1. **Call to Order**. Mario Orozco, Chair, called the meeting to order at 8:00 AM, Central Time, on March 19, 2019.
- 2. **Introductions.** Mario Orozco made the introductions.
- 3. **Approval of Meeting Minutes**. NFPA 120/122 1<sup>st</sup> draft meeting minutes dated March 20-21, 2018 were approved as written.
- 4. **Staff Update**. Debra Gursha, the new staff liaison for NFPA 120/122, provided an overview of the NFPA process and the F2019 revision cycle schedule.
- 5. **Task Group Reports.** The technical committee reviewed the work completed by the three task groups established at the first draft meeting. These were as follows:

Spirals
NFPA 30 references
Ignition sources

These task groups were thanked for their work and disbanded by the chair.

6. Review of Committee Inputs and Creation of Second Revisions.

The technical committee reviewed five committee inputs that were created for NFPA 120 and two committee inputs that were created for NFPA 122. The technical committee created second revisions as appropriate.

Information on these motions will be available in the second draft report.

There were no public comments submitted for NFPA 120 or 122.

#### 7. New Business.

Next Revision Cycle-The technical committee expressed that both NFPA 120 and 122 needed updating to reflect current processing methods for the mining industry. The technical committee requested that NFPA 120 and 122 be placed on a three year revision cycle in order



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to revise and expand language to both standards. D. Gursha offered to draft a memo and forward it to the Standards Administration with this request.

<u>Pre-First Draft Meeting</u>-In order to conduct a thorough evaluation of the language in NFPA 120 and 122, the technical committee expressed that a pre-first draft meeting was needed for the next revision cycle. Possible locations included Montreal, Phoenix or Denver.

<u>Task Groups</u>-During the next revision cycle, the technical committee recommended that the following task groups were needed:

Fire protection of conveyors and evaluation of existing suppression systems. Purpose: Investigate current language in NFPA 120 and 122 to determine if enhanced fire suppression is warranted. The committee members offering to assist are Matt Bujewski, Chair; Steve Sheldon; Chris Yoder; and Robert Taylor.

Concentrator Safety-Purpose: Investigate language in NFPA 122 to determine if additional safety practices are warranted in order to minimize loss potential. The committee members offering to assist are Matt Paine, Chair; Erick Mondragon; and Steve Behrens.

- 8. **Other Business.** The technical committee requested the contact information for the Fire Protection Research Foundation. The technical committee is planning to put a request in with the Fire Protection Research Foundation to study appropriate fire suppression for conveyor belts involved with mining operations. D. Gursha will follow up with this request.
- 9. **Adjournment.** The meeting was adjourned at 11:45 AM on March 20, 2019.
