Consent Standard Withdrawal

NFPA 16

The Technical Committee on Foam-Water Sprinklers produced a First Draft Report for NFPA 16, *Standard for the Installation of Foam-Water Sprinkler and Foam-Water Spray Systems* and sought public comment. No public comments were received on this Standard. A letter ballot of the Technical Committee/Correlating Committee (per Section 4.4.8.4 of the *Regs.*) to determine whether to hold a meeting to consider the development of Second Revisions will not be required as the Committee has fulfilled the action in accordance with the Council's vote to relocate the material within the existing NFPA 16, *Standard for the Installation of Foam-Water Sprinkler and Foam-Water Spray Systems* into the next edition of NFPA 11, *Standard for Low-, Medium-, and High-Expansion Foam*, and withdraw NFPA 16.

NOTE: *In accordance with 1.6.2(a) of the Regulations, there is a fifteen day appeal period following the publication date of this report in which one may file an appeal related to the withdrawal of this document. The final date to file any such appeal is June 16, 2020.*
