The Technical Committee on Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting notes the following error in the 2024 edition of NFPA 1900, *Standard for Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting Vehicles, Automotive Fire Apparatus, Wildland Fire Apparatus, and Automotive Ambulances*.

1. Correct the symbol in 4.5.3.5.2 to read as follows:

4.5.3.5.2 For vehicles with a water tank capacity $\leq 1999 \geq 1999$ L ($\leq 528 \geq 528$ gal), additional fuel capacity shall be provided for a minimum of 4 hours of operation of each accessory item (such as a generator or fuel-fired heaters) that uses the common fuel tank as a source.
